- 1. Educational qualification for SWA posts is Matriculation or ITI or equivalent from recognized Board/University/Institution.
- 2. The Age limit is 18-30 years. The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for the receipt of application from candidates. i.e. 30 days from the date of publication of notification and relaxation of age for SC/ST is 5 years, for OBC 3 years & Ex-Service Men/PwD as per GOI guidelines from time to time.
- 3. Selected list shall be prepared 1:3 ratio of number of posts based on merit in qualifying exam i.e. Matriculation/ITI or equivalent after scrutiny of all applications received as on last date.
- 4. Unsigned application and applications without any of the following document will summarily be rejected:-
  - (i) Age proof (ii) Certificate of essential qualification including Marks obtained in qualifying exam
  - (iii) Photograph (iv) Certificate about age relaxation (if claimed)
